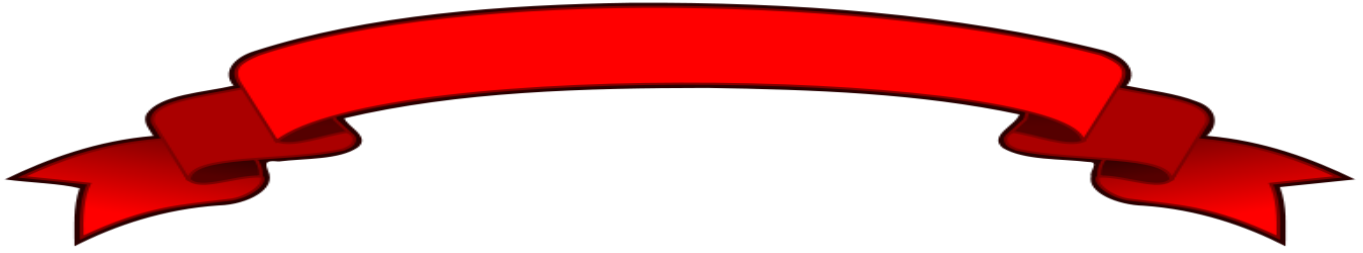
APPROPRIATE ATTIRE:
